9. Women Empowerment Camps:


Organize camps focusing on women's education, health, and entrepreneurship, providing skills training, mentorship, and support to empower rural females.


Outcomes:

Increased Student Enrollment:

The annual Sarpanch Conclave conducted every year, there has been a notable upsurge in student enrollment at our college. In the academic year 2021-2022, we enrolled a total of 250 students, with 105 originating from rural areas. The following year, 2022-2023, witnessed further growth, with 303 enrollments, including 114 students from rural backgrounds. By the academic year 2023-2024, our total enrollment expanded to 338, with 98 students hailing from rural communities. This growth trend is visually depicted in a pie chart. Presently, approximately 35% of our student body originates from rural regions within Jalandhar. This statistic underscores our dedication to inclusive education and our ongoing initiatives to provide educational opportunities to students from diverse socioeconomic backgrounds.











Analyzing Girls and Boys Admissions Data


The Sarpanch conclave scrutinized admissions data from rural areas, revealing a concerning trend. In 2021-2022, 51 girls and 54 boys were enrolled, increasing to 64 girls and 50 boys in 2022-2023, but dropping to 39 girls and 59 boys in 2023-2024. These figures underscore a fluctuating landscape in gender enrollment, urging targeted interventions for equitable education access. The conclave concluded that concerted efforts are imperative to address disparities and foster inclusive educational environments. It emphasized the urgency of empowering both girls and boys in rural communities through strategic educational initiatives.


Government Schemes Awareness:






