CT Institute of Management & IT, Maqsudan, Jalandhar, regularly administers the Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) to evaluate and analyze students' viewpoints regarding teaching, learning, institutional performance, infrastructure, and their welfare. The survey holds significant participation of students in improving the quality of education within the institution. The survey primarily employs a questionnaire comprising total 19 questions out of which 18 were choice based/objective-type and 1 question was open ended questions that cover various aspects such as teacher communication, mentor responsiveness, ICT-based education, industrial visits, internships, and more. To guarantee anonymity, students' identities are kept confidential throughout the survey process. All currently enrolled undergraduate and postgraduate students, totaling approximately 764 individuals, were invited to participate. Within this group, around 258 students voluntarily responded anonymously, ensuring objectivity throughout the entire process.

The questionnaire was distributed through a WhatsApp group using the following link: https://forms.gle/btFmtMwZANsBbUZL6. A total of 258 out of the 764 students responded to the Survey, and their responses were duly recorded.

- 1. Majority of students shows satisfactions for Teaching Learning process, Which indicates positive sign for a institution.
- 2. Some students expressed need of more practical assignments and job focused lectures emphasizing student's interest for bright future.
- 3. It is worth noting that some students expressed more need of ICT Tools based education to make teaching leaning more interesting.
- 4. Some students expressed more discussion on current affairs topics via Debates and seminars which will improve engagement of students.
- 5. Additionally, a small group of students expressed need of teaching with real time examples and need updation in syllabus with current trends.
